UPCOMING RALLIES



HUNTINGTON BEACH

Sunset Vista Camping Facility Huntington Beach, California March 5th - 10th, 2017

Sunset Vista Camping Facility is located right on the beach in Huntington Beach, California and just south of the Huntington Beach Pier. Visitors are often at a loss for words when they arrive and get their first look at the world of Surf City USA – miles of broad sands, surfers catching waves near the pier,

and sunsets that paint the sky in vivid hues of pink, violet, and orange. This glorious ocean scene is

only the beginning of what awaits when you visit Southern California's classic beach town.

With 10 miles of beaches and a lively downtown filled with shops and restaurants, Huntington Beach blends surfing's relaxed spirit with a contemporary style which creates an ocean side destination like nowhere else on the California coast. We will be staying for 5 nights arriving on Sunday March 5th and departing on Friday March 10th. The weather will be absolutely wonderful. It takes just under 6 hours to get there.

Lou and Eileen have been here many times and have a list of sites you can visit on your own or with others. We are planning a Welcome Night pizza party and nightly Happy Hours and appetizers, campfires on the beach, lunch at Ruby's on the pier, and an evening on Main street on Tuesday night when the streets are closed to accommodate live bands, craft fair, and farmers markets. We are also planning a bicycle ride to Newport beach for those who are interested or it is just a short drive by car.

10 sites have already been reserved and paid for. There is currently a waiting list because there may be cancellations. Once you put your name on the Grand RVers Huntington Beach Rally page, your payment in full is due within 5 days. The first 10 paid sites will be confirmed. All others must get on the waiting list or book directly with Huntington Beach City if sites are still available. Here is the link to the direct Huntington Beach website;

All sites are partial hookups; there is 30 and 50 amp service and water to all sites but no sewer hookup. However, there is a free dump station on site. Book early... it is a rally you won't forget.

Cost of the rally is \$375 per RV. This includes the reservation fee, application fee, and 1st night pizza party.
